

## FUNDRAISING BBQ EVENT POLICY

Basketball ACT (BACT) invites junior representative teams and clubs to assist in the promotion of major events by conducting a Barbeque at Belconnen Stadium as a fundraising initiative for each program. For some events there may also be an additional opportunity for fundraising at Tuggeranong and Woden stadium

Teams and clubs will be allocated an event by the BACT Kiosk Manager. Negotiations of who will service what events will be undertaken by BACT staff.

### Fundraising Opportunities:

- Basketball ACT has the sale rights to all stadium canteen items ie – drinks – hot & cold, lollies, hot chips, fresh fruit and sandwiches.
- Fundraising groups at this time are required to provide – BBQ, Shelter, tables.
- Fundraising groups can sell.
  - BBQ items Steak Sandwiches, Sausage Sandwiches, Bacon & Egg Roll
  - Roast beef roll etc.
  - Morning tea baked items ie muffins, cakes etc.
- All funds raised by the group are theirs to keep.
- Fundraising groups can have limited access to a refrigerated storage area where items can be kept. Volunteers are not granted open access to the canteen sales area except for minimal access to wash up area behind the fridges.
- In co-ordinating fundraising catering days the fundraising group are to liaise with the Kiosk manager directly.
