

## PLAYER ELIGIBILITY IN INDIVIDUAL GAMES POLICY

A team can protest the eligibility of individual player or players, in terms of the relevant Competition By-Laws, to participate in a specific game.

- The appealing team must submit its grounds of appeal in writing to the Competition Manager within seven days of the specific game.
- The Competition Operations Group (COG) decision will only relate to the specific game in question.
- Where more than 50% of competing teams within the specific competition have raised similar appeals, or where COG deems it appropriate, the appeal may be extended to other games not necessarily played in by the appellant teams.
- Customer Service Officers or any other BACT officials are not authorized to give definitive decisions on such protests.

Appeals relating to a player being eligible to play in any finals game must be lodged at least 7 days PRIOR to the first final game.
