

JUNIOR DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM PARTICIPATION IN SENIOR PREMIER POLICY

Team Nomination:

- Nomination must be submitted as per the details in the Season's nomination package.
- The club (team) delegate will be the Team Manager.
- The nomination must be endorsed by the High Performance Manager prior to submission.
- A 10% reduction of team fees will be offered.
- As with all nominations Basketball ACT holds the right to reject any nomination.
- All Individuals games played with the ACT Representative team qualify for eligibility for their own club in all finals.

Athletes:

- The team can nominate up to 20 athletes for the season.
- All athletes must be current squad members for the respective program.
- Are required to register per as all other athletes in the league (On-line Registration form).
- Athletes will be eligible to play for their club if not required for their Junior Representative team.
- Athletes can only play ONE (1) game of Div#1 or Div#2 Senior Premier League (ACPL) per competition round.
 - Fined \$100 for non-compliance.
- Athletes that are registered with the opposing Premier club team in that game, in the first instance are to play for their Premier Club team as a priority.
- Athletes who are registered to play in the Div#2 Senior Premier League and the ACT Representative team is entered into Div#1 Senior Premier, is permitted to play for both teams on 2 different nights in the same round and week.
- The athletes are still required to play their junior game as priority. (Except ACTAS Scholarship athletes who have workload schedules that prioritise senior, AIS or Australian Junior Program involvement.)

Team Lists:

- A maximum of 12 athletes per game.
- Team list must be submitted to the Competition Manager by 12pm of the Monday prior tip off.
- Team list is to be sent to league mailing list once received by the Competition Manager.
- The list is final once Competition Manager distributes to clubs, changes cannot be made.
