



## Canberra Classic Rules 2023

### Competition Rules Invitational

#### Timing

- ✚ 8 Minute quarters, fully timed.
- ✚ 14 & 24 second shot clock.

#### Time Outs

- ✚ 2-Time outs per team in the first half, 3- Time outs per team in the second half – The clock will stop for the duration of the time out.

#### Breaks

- ✚ 1 minute at the 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter break.
- ✚ 3 minutes at half time break.

#### Extra Time

- ✚ No draws – Invitational 3-minute extra time will be played until a result is obtained, which will be fully timed.

#### Basketball

- ✚ Teams must supply their own warm-up balls; match balls will be provided by a BACT staff member.
- ✚ Size 7 basketball will be used for all men's games in the competition.
- ✚ Size 6 basketball will be used for all women's games in the competition.

#### Officials & Duty

- ✚ BACT will provide Officials and duty for all games in the competition.





## Competition Rules A - C Grade

### Timing

- ⚡ 10 Minute running clock – The last 2 minutes of the last quarter will be fully timed.
- ⚡ No 24 second shot clock.

### Time Outs

- ⚡ 1 time out per team, per quarter – The clock will stop for the duration of the time out.

### Breaks

- ⚡ 1 minute at the 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter break.
- ⚡ 3 minutes at half time.

### Extra Time – there must be a result. (No draws)

- ⚡ A grade, B grade & C grade will play 2 minutes of extra time, the game will be played until a result is obtained
- ⚡ Extra time will be fully timed.

### Basketball

- ⚡ Teams must supply their own warm-up balls; match balls will be provided by a BACT staff member.
- ⚡ Size 7 basketball will be used for all men's games in the competition.
- ⚡ Size 6 basketball will be used for all women's games in the competition.

### Officials and Duty

- ⚡ BACT will provide Officials for all games in the competition.
- ⚡ Teams will be **REQUIRED** to supply someone to do bench on their own games in the competition.
